#### INTRODUCTION

Macheo cooperates with 28 schools in the Thika area, Kenya, among other things, by providing school meals and desks. School meals ensure that many more children attend school, reducing dropout rates and improving concentration and education Providing healthy and performance. nutritious meals positively impacts students' physical health, cognitive function, and academic performance.

We are so grateful to stichting K.O.O.K. and TOP Foundation for supporting this project to see 250 children from Kwa Mutu Primary School have porridge to enhance their concentration in school.



### FINANCIALS

We have been able to carry out all proposed changes within the budget and have even been able to make a few extra improvements. Due to a more favourable exchange rate than anticipated, and high contributions by the school community, we still have an amount of KES 96.462 (appr €736 with today's exchange rate) left.

Upgrading to a new modern kitchen offers several benefits, such as increased storage space for kitchen equipment, reduced clutter, and improved environmental sustainability. Additionally, modern kitchen designs are durable, making them a smart investment in the long run, saving money over time. Providing porridge to school children has been linked to improved concentration and academic performance. The water storage tank not only provides cooking water but also drinking water for the learners.

The construction of the new kitchen at Kwa Mutu Primary School has significantly improved the hygiene of food preparation and serving. An internal store was built, allowing the cook to store utensils within the kitchen, thus reducing the risk of unhealthy situations or diseases that may affect the children.

Parents contributed sand and water for the construction, supervised by Macheo staff, teachers, and the school board of management. The new kitchen has been equipped with energy-saving modern stoves, and a water storage tank was purchased for the school, with gutters installed to address water security challenges.

### Testimony from the head teacher

" Previously, we used a small old kitchen with no floor. It was usually muddy during the rainy seasons and was insufficient to serve porridge for the children and store firewood. It was also unsafe since it was made of weak wire mesh, which could be broken and utensils stolen. It was also challenging for the cook because it was not well-ventilated and was usually full of smoke which posed health risks to the cook and the children.

With the new kitchen, it's now easier for the cook to prepare porridge for the children. We now have modern cooking stoves which emit little smoke, and our school cook feels more comfortable and happy when working. The kitchen is also now cemented so we can easily clean it and efficiently serve more children during the rainy seasons. With such a clean kitchen, we are most likely to serve clean meals, reducing health-related issues. The school, parents and the community are happy and grateful for Macheo and the donors for constructing the new kitchen!"
